ACTIVITIES

FOR YOUR SAFETY

The well-equipped medical centre on site will be supervised by Dr Rosemary Gradwell, who will head a team of experienced medical staff. To assist them, a medical details form (copy sent to groups) should be completed for each person attending; these will be held only for the duration of the event. Leaders are asked to advise us if anyone in a group has special needs, so that our staff may make any necessary provision for their enjoyment and safety.

The Fire Brigade has asked that we remind everyone that open fires are not allowed on site.

SECURITY

The Police will be responsible for security on the site and everyone will receive a pass, which they will be expected to carry at all times. Passes for young people will have an individual number on them instead of the name. There will be an allocation of day tickets for parents/friends who wish to visit and there is a leaflet (copy sent to groups) giving details of booking arrangements and prices.

SHOPS & BAR

A wide range of gifts and confectionery will be available daily from the shop on site; eat in our international café and relax during the evening in our licensed bar.

Groups are requested to ensure that everyone over 18 years of age visiting the camp holds an enhanced Criminal Records Bureau disclosure. This will apply to any day visitors who may wish to book a visit to a group.
